THE TIE THAT BINDS

Let's use a little ink here to talk about adjustments: For 10 years we were abundantly blessed by the generosity of our Post Office, the goodness of the people in Spring Hill, and the can-do spirit of love that persists in the Spring Meadows Family here. Through the Stamp Out Hunger Food Drive, we collected over 100,000 pounds of food that we turned around to people in need in our area. It required a mass blitz of our members to make it happen. Last year and then again this year the Postal Union canned their food drive nationwide. But the needs of our neighbors have not been canceled. We have continued to adjust and adapt.

The committee that helps make The Pantry so effective has a plan. It will take a lot of us and some personal initiative, but we can do this. We need you to help.

So, go to your neighborhood association's Facebook page. Ask your neighborhood and friends to donate food for our drive. You might

ask them to put non-perishable food items by their mailbox by 11am on the 17th or have them drop them by your house. The Pantry is asking for no canned corn, green beans, cornmeal mix, Mac n cheese, or ramen noodles (this is up to you. YOU may not want to limit the people giving on what they can give and make it more complicated, but that is up to you). Then bring the items to the building by noon that day.
