Daily Bible Study

Scott Ford and I will periodically teach a One-Year Bible Class. The purpose of this class is to get you in the habit of reading and studying the Bible on a daily basis. You can find various reading plans at oneyearbibleonline.com. Find a time each day that is free from distraction which allows you to focus on the Word. Pray before and after you read and then spend time in contemplation over the passage.

There are 66 books in the Bible divided into two sections, the Old and New Testament. The Old Testament contains Books of the Law, Historical Books, Wisdom Literature (Poetry), and Prophets while the New Testament has the Gospels, History, Epistles (Letters), and Prophetic/Apocalyptic Literature. Human experiences as well as the range of our emotions are all covered in these books.

What is the overarching theme of the Bible? Quite simply, it is Jesus Christ – His coming, His presence, and His return. Luke 24:27 says “Then starting with what Moses and all the prophets had said about him, Jesus began to explain everything that had been written about himself in the Scriptures.”

Just as we eat every day, we need to be fed by the Word, Matthew 4:4 and in Romans 10:17 we are told that our faith will grow through the word of Christ (reading/studying). “Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth” – 2 Timothy 2:15.
