Weather Pending: The Garage Bible Study on Monday night at 7pm - I will send out a message if we are having it.

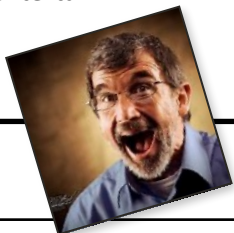
TODAY IS LAST DAY TO SIGN UP FOR CYC! Sign up if you plan to go!
