This Morning, Everything Changes

Welcome home, Spring Meadows family — and to every guest who has joined us today, welcome. We are so glad you are here. Of all the Sundays on the calendar, this is the one where we want you to know: you did not wander into just another church service. You walked into a family that believes something that changes everything.

Last Sunday, we stood together at the foot of the cross. We didn't look away. We let the weight of it settle — the suffering, the darkness, the silence of that Friday afternoon. We saw love in its most costly form: a Savior who gave Himself completely, who cried out "It is finished," and meant every word. The cross is not a tragedy with a silver lining. It is the turning point of all human history. And yet — the cross was never meant to be the last word.

Because Sunday morning came.

The tomb is empty. The grave clothes are folded. The stone is rolled away — not to let Him out, but to let us look in. And what we find changes not just a story from two thousand years ago, but the story of your life and mine today.

The apostle Paul could not contain it: "And if Christ has not been raised, your faith is futile and you are still in your sins. But in fact Christ has been raised from the dead." (1 Corinthians 15:17, 20)

But in fact. Three words that change things...

The resurrection is not a footnote to the cross — it is the Father's thunderous "Yes!" to everything the Son accomplished there. The cross paid the debt. The empty tomb proved the payment was accepted. Together, they are the heartbeat of the gospel, and together, they are the foundation of every hope we carry into this broken world.

This morning, we don't celebrate a memory. We worship a living King. He is not in the tomb. He is here — in this room, in this family, in the lives of people who have been forever changed by His grace.

Whatever brought you through those doors today — curiosity, tradition, a friend's invitation, or a hunger you can't quite name — we believe God brought you here for a reason. And we are honored to worship alongside you.

He is risen. He is risen indeed. - *Chuck*
